THE OLD WORLD IN BRIEF. London bridge is still closely watched by detectives.

THE SIEGE OF SONTAY.

A PARTIAL VICTORY FOR THE FRENCH FORCES.

Large numbers of slain on both sides.—The Citadel surrounded.—A stubborn Resistance.

HONG KONG, Dec. 20.—The French forces have captured the principal fortifications of Sontay, embracing five strongly fortified villages. The enemy made a stubborn resistance. The French lost 800 men, and 15 officers killed and wounded. Admiral Courbet, who commanded the expedition, had 7000 men, of whom 4000 were engaged, the remainder being held in reserve. The Chinese still hold the fortress of Sontay. It is reported that 1000 Chinese were killed and wounded. The fight occurred Dec. 14. Two of the outworks were captured and the citadel surrounded.

PARIS, Dec. 20.—In the senate to-day the supplementary credit bill for aid to the Tonquin expedition was adopted by 211 to 7. Subsequently the Tonquin credit bill for twenty million francs was also adopted by 215 to 6.

Six thousand three hundred troops will be sent to Tonquin in the next fortnight. During the Tonquin debate to-day, Admiral Jaureguiberry insisted that either the credit be voted or France abandon her influence in her Indo-Chinese possessions. If she should abandon Tonquin she would surrender 400,000 Christians to butchery. France can wage successful war like China, but she cannot win the rights of neutrals. He refused to believe in the ill-will of England. Admiral Ferry said a published dispatch from Sontay said "I believe our troops only encountered Black Flags. I do not believe the Chinese regulars were engaged in the battle of Sontay. The Chinese regulars are not inspired and of supreme utility; that the statement of the rights of neutrals is not eternal. On the ground of having preached these doctrines he holds that Mr. Bray is not legally the minister of the congress."

A Washington Correspondent. Hon. John Sherman, Holibird reported a joint resolution requesting the president to issue a proclamation recommending the people, by public observances on Dec. 24, to commemorate the surrender by Washington of his commission as commander-in-chief. The president is expected to sign the resolution.

Two Admirals of the World-Be Beglaid Cause a Disturbance in the Italian Chamber. Rome, Dec. 20.—During the sitting in the chamber of deputies to-day two men in the gallery caused great confusion by shouting "Viva Oberland," and throwing copies of Oberland's will into the body of the chamber. They were arrested. Oberland is the man who was arrested at Trieste while manufacturing bombs a year ago. He confessed to the Italian authorities to which he belonged to determine whether he was sane. He was sane, and he intended to throw a bomb into the gallery of Miranour castle to accompany the death of the man who was subsequently hanged.

An Accident to the czar. His Majesty Thrown while Hunting and Slightly Hurt. Berlin, Dec. 20.—The czar while hunting in the forest of the war and having a horse thrown, was injured. Grave fears for a time were entertained, but the telegram states the injuries are not serious.

The Glasgow Dynamiter. Edinburgh, Dec. 20.—The lord advocate closed the case for the crown in the trial of the dynamiter to-day. He claimed that the dynamiter proved they conspired to bring about the explosion with which they are charged. Counsel then addressed the jury in behalf of the accused.

The German Embassy Resigns. London, Dec. 20.—William Wolff and Edward Bonhoeffer, charged with having in their possession explosives intended to be used in blowing up the German embassy, have been committed for trial. Bail was refused.

Congress Will Have Some of Its House of Representatives. Washington, Dec. 20.—In the house of representatives yesterday the resolution reported by the committee on woman suffrage, which would give the vote to woman, was rejected by 124 to 88.

An ex-Policeman to Be Hanged. New York, Dec. 20.—Ex-Policeman Controy, who killed Peter Keenan, was today sentenced to be hanged. He is a native of Ireland. He was convicted of the murder of Peter Keenan, a fellow Irishman, in New York city.

THE CANTILEVER BRIDGE A TRAGEDY AT QUEBEC.

A SUCCESSFUL TEST AND A FORMAL OPENING.

Twenty locomotives span the mighty Niagara Falls, Ont., Dec. 20.—The cantilever bridge, now being laid by running 20 engines on it, and proved successful, with ballast on it, and the two sections moved out about 11.30 the two sections moved out on each track. The committee of engineers inspected each section of the structure when the train was standing on the bridge.

It before allowing them to go farther, and the ponderous weight rested entirely on the structure from people who lined both sides of the river after cheer. The twenty bridges of the river on the bridge opened an engine across the bridge opened a continuous whistling for fifteen minutes.

The engines in the Grand Trunk yards greeted their whistles, and the great excitement prevailed for some thirty minutes among the 15,000 spectators.

Every train that passed yesterday morning on the opening, and scientific men of both the United States and Canada witnessed about the cantilever at this grand banquet at the Montebello hotel this afternoon.

At 2:45 p.m. the first passenger train across the bridge arrived from the Niagara river, near the falls, built for the Grand Central and Michigan Central railroads, is the only one of its kind in the world. It is located about 500 feet above the water level, and is a cantilever bridge, spanning the chasm 870 feet wide between the bluffs, and over a distance of 1,100 feet.

The structure consists of two immense cantilever towers, 132 feet 6 inches high, resting on stone piers 39 feet high, and supported by a cantilever 305 feet long, one end of which is anchored to an abutment at the edge of the bluff, while the other end extends over the river, and is supported by a cantilever 190 feet long, which is suspended from the extreme ends of the river.

The total length of the bridge is 1,100 feet, and the height from the surface of water to base of rail is 228 feet.
