Trips to be made every three weeks. Steamers to be not over 1,000 tons, nor less than 700 tons registered tonnage. The contract to be for a period of 5 years.
- 2nd. A line of mail steamers sailing from Halifax to St. Thomas, thence to Ponce, thence to Matanzas, thence to San Juan in Porto Rico, and thence to Halifax, calling at Bermuda going and returning.
