ROMAN NEWS.

Passing to the position of the Church in Italy, His Holiness complained of the trouble caused by the refusal in so many cases of the exequatur. Latterly that difficulty had been removed, but in other respects the condition of the Holy See remained unaltered. It was a condition which was unworthy of the Roman Pontiff, which could be productive of no advantage to Italy, and in which his sense of right and duty would not allow him to acquiesce. On the contrary, said His Holiness, we claim, and shall never cease to claim, all the rights of the Apostolic See.

His Holiness in his recent allocution etrongly condemned the introduction of civil marriage in Hungary. We could not, said he, pass the matter over in silence without failing in our duty. Let those whose province it is consider how painful and contrary to justice it is to prescribe for a Catholic people a form of marriage which has been condemned a hundred times by the Church.

The Vatican Library at Rome has lost its two most valuable officers, Mgr. Carini, custodian and editor of the Papal Regesta. His colleague, the Rev. Father Bollig, S. J., who filled the office of subcustodian and was the editor of several valuable Oriental manuscripts, has also passed away.

The propaganda has examined and approved Cardinal Vaughan's report on English Catholic students at Oxford and Cambridge Universities, and a code of rules for their guidance will be sent to them through the Bishops of the dioceses. in which they reside.

St. Patrick's Church in the Eternal City is approaching completion.

A new maternity hospital was opened a few days ago in Dublin by His Grace the Archbishop. It is situated in Hoilis street. This institution became necessary on account of the exclusiventes practiced against Catholics in the management of the Rotunda Hospital.
