

Those corporations listed in Schedule 'D' of the Financial Administration Act, as well as those agencies not listed in the Act, will be responsible for taking measures to ensure that the provisions of the Official Languages Act are respected and that federal official languages policies are implemented by them. It will be the responsibility of the Minister who is designated as the appropriate Minister, or who is the trustee shareholder on behalf of the Government of Canada, to inform these agencies of Government policies and to review and monitor their progress. They will be responsible for submitting to the Minister an official languages plan or report which will also be available to the public.

'Parent' corporations will be held responsible for ensuring the appropriate implementation of official languages policies for 'subsidiary' and 'associated' corporations. Those agencies which are 'mixed enterprise corporations' in which the Government of Canada shares an equity interest will be fully informed of federal official languages policies by the Minister who acts as trustee shareholder and will be asked to implement appropriate programs.
