Dear Governor Sanchez,

This will confirm that, in the context of the Textile Agreement between the Governments of Canada and the Republic of the Philippines initialled on April 6, 1978, any shipment of clothing or textiles from the Philippines to Canada valued at less than \$250 (Canadian) f.o.b. does not require an export license and shall not be subject to the agreed restraint levels. In addition, export licenses are not required for shipment of bonafide commercial samples that meet Canadian Customs requirements.
