PAGE 25 OFIDE 25 possible methods of other procedures, and explore of strengthening them. Furthermore, the publication programme and other promotional activities of the Centre and of other relevant organizational components could be the subject of study.

OBJECTIVE 6.

> To make recommendations for ensuring the necessary "(£) financial and other resources for the United Nations activities in the promotion and protection of human rights and fundamental freedoms."

Annotation: Keeping in mind article 1 of the United Nations Charter, the study should include an examination of ways and means to strengthen the position of human rights as one of the future priorities of the United Nations system with an emphasis on co-operation between all the relevant organs and agencies. In this respect, the study would look at the role of the United Nations Centre for Human Rights as a coordinating unit and focal point of human rights activities in the entire United Nations system. The Commission on Human Rights, in several resolutions, has called on the Centre to assume the role of the coordinating unit and focal point in the human rights field. The study should, inter alia. analyse the Centre's existing mandates and activities under the triangular approach to human rights, as well its present and future coordinating role. 38 Furthermore, the study should spell out the human and financial resources necessary to achieve this objective.
