The Department of External Affairs announced today that the Honourable Howard Beale, Australian Minister of Supply, will arrive in Montreal this morning, July 20, for a visit of a few days to Canada. This afternoon Mr. Beale will travel to Chalk River and tomorrow morning, July 21, will visit the installations of the Atomic Energy of Canada Limited there. He will come to Ottawa tomorrow evening and on Friday will call upon the Prime Minister, the Right Honourable Louis S. St. Laurent; the Minister of Trade and Commerce and of Defence Production, the Right Honourable C. D. Howe; and various government officials. Mr. Howe will entertain at luncheon on Friday in honour of Mr. Beale. On Saturday morning Mr. Beale will leave Ottawa for a visit to Arvida, Quebec, as the guest of the Aluminum Company of Canada. He will depart for Washington, D.C. on Sunday evening.

Mr. Beale will be accompanied by his wife and by Mr. F. Hinchellwood and Mr. E. A. Cook of the Ministry of Supply.
