Since 1977, Miss Andreychuk has also been the Honorary Patron to Match International (Matching Women's Needs in Canada and the Third World). In 1969, she was a Canadian delegate to the United Nations Conference on Women and Development in New York; in 1979, Chairperson of the First Canadian Conference bringing non-governmental international agencies together to discuss their role in development (sponsored by the Canadian International Development Agency); and, in 1980, a member and participant at the United Nations Conference on Women in Copenhagen.

For the past 20 years, Miss Andreychuk has gained a reputation as a lecturer and speaker on such topics as family issues, women's issues and the voluntary sector. Since 1981, she has been a lecturer at the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Training Depot, Regina, Saskatchewan. Since 1985, Miss Andreychuk has been Associate Deputy Minister, Saskatchewan Social Services. Miss Andreychuk replaces Mr. D.M. Miller.
