PRAYERS.

As a mark of respect and sorrow, the Members of the House, standing in their places, observed one minute of silent tribute in commemoration of the late President of the United States of America, Mr. John F. Kennedy.

By unanimous consent, it was agreed that, for today's sitting:

- (1) the House proceed forthwith to Government Orders to consider legislation;
- (2) the hour for Private Members' Business be suspended; and
- (3) the House shall adjourn at 6.00 o'clock p.m., until tomorrow at 2.30 o'clock p.m.

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole to consider a certain proposed resolution to amend the Railway Act.

(In the Committee)

The following resolution was adopted:

Resolved,—That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Railway Act, chapter 40 of the statutes of 1958, as amended by chapter 35 of the statutes of 1960, to permit certain grants to be made from the Railway Grade Crossing Fund for a further period of three years beyond January 31, 1964.

Resolution to be reported.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in.
