An Act to amend the Canadian Citizenship Act

1. The purpose of this bill is to amend the Canadian Citizenship Act to make it possible for applicants for Canadian citizenship in the case of all persons who are presently employed to appear before a citizenship court without loss of pay for the time of work up to a maximum of three hours for any one appearance, which it may be necessary to take in order to appear before the court as required by law. The requirement that an employer grant such time of work without loss of pay is similar to the requirement in the Canada Labor Act regarding the loss of wages at certain elections. It is felt that requiring Canadian citizenship should be granted this recognition of the importance of the citizenship act.

2.
