1. Bill No. 6, An Act to amend the Criminal Code; presented: Mr. Miller, 38. Bill read second time; referred to a Special Committee, 177, 178. Committee granted additional powers, 225. Reported amended, 676. Motion for Mr. Speaker to leave the Chair; objection taken, 806. Mr. Speaker's ruling; appeal therefrom negatived, 807. Motion agreed to; House went into Committee; progress reported, 808. House went again into Committee of the Whole; progress reported, 816. Again considered; reported amended; considered as amended; read third time, passed, 878. Passed by Senate, 1013. Royal Assent, 1100.—9-10 Edward VII., Chapter 10.
2. Bill No. 75, An Act to amend the Criminal Code; presented: Mr. Harris, 235. Read second time and referred to a Special Committee, 320. Reported amended, 387. Considered in Committee of the Whole; reported; read third time; passed, 1034. Passed by Senate, 1067. Royal Assent, 1101.—9-10 Edward VII., Chapter 11.
