509	To provide for loans to the Federal District Commission (hereinafter called "the Commission"), for the purpose of acquiring property in the National Capital District that is not immediately required for the purposes of the Commission; the loans to be made in such amounts and on such terms and conditions as the Governor in Council prescribes, except that when a property so acquired has been commenced to be used for a purpose of the Commission, an amount equal to the cost of acquisition of the property shall be repaid from the National Capital Fund or other fund or account from which expenditures may be made for the purposes of the Commission . . . . .	3,000,000 00
