9. All members present and entitled 'to vote must vote on the election of candidates to membership unless excused by the presiding officer.

ARTICLE III.

MEETINGS.

I. The regular meetings of the Society shall be held on the last Tuesday of every month at the rooms of the Society. Eleven members in good standing shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

2. Special meetings may be called by the Chief Factor at his discretion, and must be called upon the written request of any five members in good standing, and the Recording Secretary shall notify the members thereof in time to render their presence possible.

3. No business shall be transacted at a special meeting other than that for which it may have been called.

4. The meetings of the Society shall be presided over by the Chief Factor, and in his absence by either of the Vice-Factors, and in their absence by the Senior Past Chief Factor present, and in his absence any member in good standing may be called upon to preside by a majority of those present.

ARTICLE IV.

OFFICERS.

1. The officers of the Society shall be a Chief Factor, two Vice-Factors and Honorary Treasurer, a
