dangers, he traced this coast almost two thousand miles, from the 38° of south latitude, cross the tropic, to its northern extremity, within 10° and a half of the equinoctial, where it joined the land already explored by the Dutch, which they have denominated New Holland.

The voyages projected by his prefent Majesty George the Third, and carried into execution by Captain Cook, have not, it is prefumed, been useless. When Great Britain was first visited by the Phoenicians, the inhabitants were painted favages, much less civilized than those of Tongataboo, or Otaheite; and it is not impossible, but that our late voyages may, in process of time, spread the bleffings of civilization among the numerous islanders of the South Pacific Ocean, and be the means of abolishing their abominable repasts, and almost equally abominable facrifices.
