Two millions of downrs had been secured by the G-W V.A. for relatives of soldiers since its foundation. Sergt. Turley said. There are 33,000 Great War Veterans and 200 branches of the association scattered for association scattered from east to west in the Dominion.

"There are organizations alleged to be founded for the benefit of returned men springing up all over the country." Sergt. Turley said. "But the Great War Veterans' Association has the distinction of height the organization as height. The association was established that men who have bled in France may be cared for all their life if need be. The twelve survivors of the 'Charge of the Light Brigade,' when they approached Lord Tennyson for monetary aid were told that a huge bazaar would be given for their benefit in London, Emgland. The entertainment was given but the proceeds were so meagre, owing to bad management, that the survivors of the famous charge secured but one pound each. This is something that we are here to confend with. Our association must not lack for leadership. It must be well managed and efficient if the returned men are to receive their just due for services overseas." seas."

SEND INQUIRIES TO MILITIA HEADQUARTERS


