Grant, said he hoped some solution would be found this session of the demand that the education act be amended to include the value of the buildings in ascertaining the cost of education, and that a definite percentage of this value be added to the centage of this value be added to the annual cost of maintenance, and 100 per cent. of this ascertained cost be collectable from all municipalities taking advantage of the accommoda-
