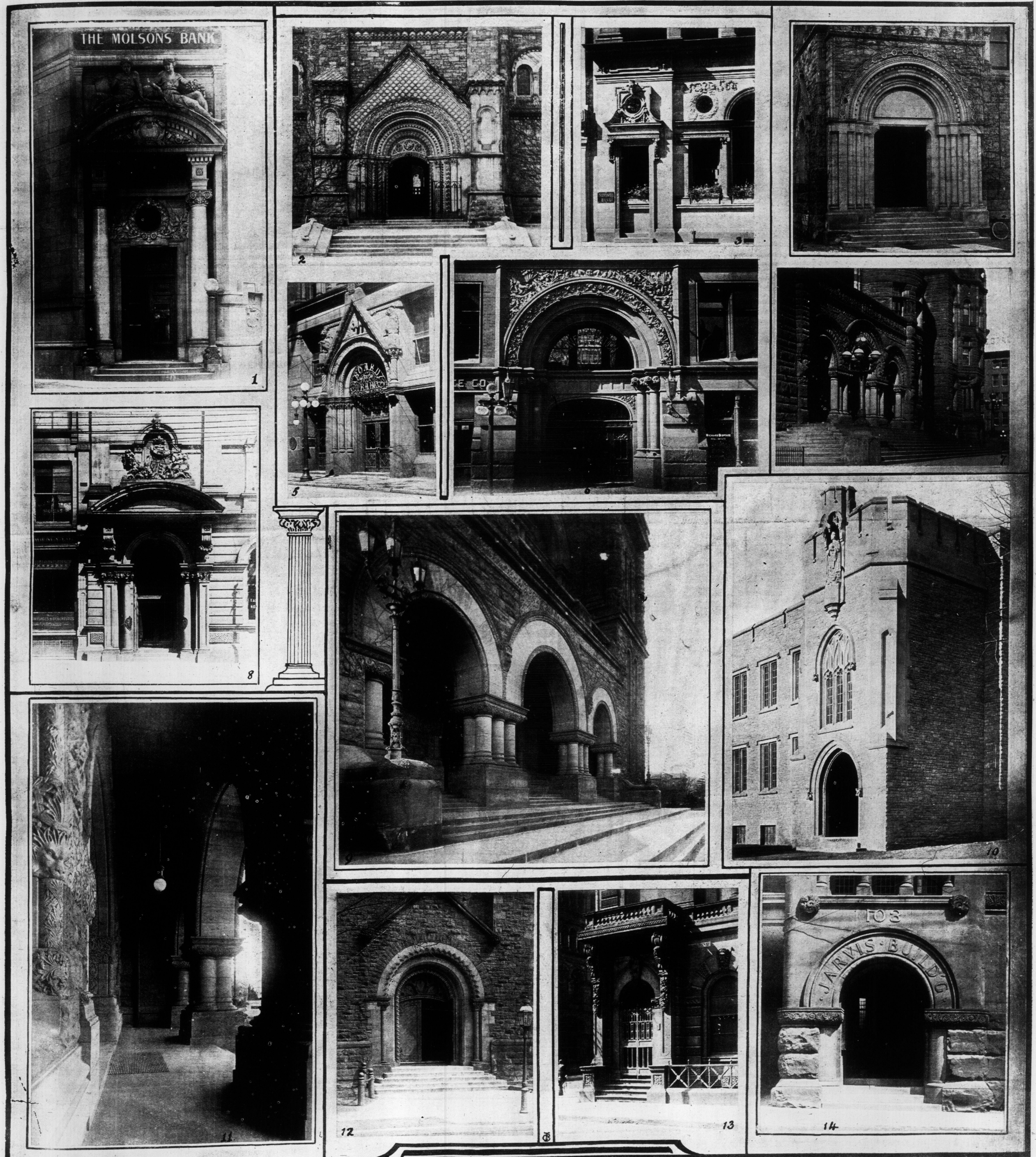


Toronto's Artistic Fronts, Illustrating Varied Architectural Styles
