On the whole the daring scheme mapped out by the Germans as a grand sequel to the capture of Warsaw—the destruction of the Russian army—is unfolding itself slowly, as must be the case from its very magnitude. With the three main railways, besides those built since the war, it is believed in mili-tary circles here that the Grand Duke Nicholas will be able to extricate his Warsaw army. 


