U. S. CLAIMS TO BE

RICHEST NATION

If Wealth Were Divided Evenly Every Person Would Get \$1,965

Washington, July 7.—The United States, the richest country in the world, has accumulated so much wealth that if it were divided there would be \$1,965 for every person in this country. This is announced in a report by the Census Bureau.

The bureau estimates the total value of all property in the United States exclusive of Alaska and the insular possessions in 1912 at \$187,739,000,000, or \$1,965 per capita. The increase between 1904 and 1912 was 75 per cent. for the total amount and forty-nine per cent per capita, but the increase in debt also reached a considerable figure. Comparing the increase in wealth with the increase in indebtedness and taxation, the census bureau says:

"The increase in national wealth of 75 per cent in eight years indicating a gain of 115 per cent in eleven years in the ten years from 1902 to 1912, the increase in the tax levies during the same period amounted to 86 per cent. Real estate and improvements, including public property alone, constituted \$110,077,000,000 or 59 per cent of the total wealth increase."

The net public indebtedness in 1913 amounted to \$4,850,461,000. This amount includes, among other items: National debt, \$2,000,000,000; State debt, \$3,845,942,000, or \$3.57 per capita; and municipal debt, \$2,844,888,000, or \$2.87 per capita. While there was an increase of 66 per cent in the national debt, there was a decrease of 18 per cent in the per capita figures.
