CAIRO, Egypt, April 18—Both Captain Esteves, leader of the Spanish expedition for Manila and his mechanic Calvo, are in hospital at Amman. After being missing since Sunday last on their flight from Cairo to Baghdad, when they were compelled to make a landing in the Syrian desert, Esteves was found yesterday by Flying Officer Cahill, of the British Air Force, while Calvo was found in an exhausted condition about 25 miles further along the road to Amman.
