IN CHINA

A cable to the Times yesterday stated that the revolutionists in China were not responsible for outrages on foreigners, and that on the contrary they were careful to protect the interests of foreigners.

The Times a few days ago quoted some interesting extracts from the Oriental Review, a Japanese publication, giving an account of the career of the man who has been chosen by the Manchus to be their champion.

"The revolution which is now apparently proceeding so successfully has taken years for its preparation, its leaders working in secret or openly, sometimes at home but more often abroad.


