County Council Committee Unable to Meet Request of Lawyers.

The building committee of the Municipal Council in session yesterday decided that they could not accede to the request of the St. John Law Society expounded by several of the leading lawyers of the city, but that they would if possible try to satisfy the society's demands within the confines of the present building and authorized the architect to investigate and see if a solution could be found. The request of the barristers, he said, virtually amounted to the building of two wings, one on thing street East and the other branching from that new wing, at a possible cost of from \$100,000 to \$150,000. The cost of the restoration of the present court house, he said, would be about \$97,000.

Law Society's Views.

The suggestions of the Law Society were outlined by W. H. Harrison. He said it was the wish of the society that provision be made in the building for the accomodation of all the courts and the law library. In order to do this they suggested that a wing be built to the east, along the King street face of the lot, the same height as the present building, that, in the main building, the street floor be left for county purposes, the second floor for the judges' chambers and the third


