HOW TURPENTINE IS MADE.

The operation of turpentine pine trees does not lower the strength of resin content of the wood, according to information obtained by the Forest Products Laboratory at Madison, Wis. The crude turpentine, or oleosin, is not drained from a store in the tree, but is manufactured under the stimulus of the wound by living cells in the sapwood immediately adjacent to the cut on the trunk.

The major part of the tree is not appreciably affected, and the loss due to death of trees or to a reduction or degradation of lumber is very small. Furthermore this loss is more than offset by the additional revenue obtained through turpentine. The greater part of the wood that is chipped away would not have become finished lumber but would have gone into slabs and edgings at the sawmill. With proper treatment, the turpentine fumes remain healthy, and the wood underneath does not become saturated with resin to any great extent.
