We come to the end of another year of our work, feeling that a great deal has been accomplished by the few members who have taken an interest in the work.

The number of paid members for the year is 28. Aver-

age attendance at meetings during the year, 9.

Many of the members visited who did not attend the meetings, so that our actual working membership is greater than the average attendance at the meetings shows. Number of visits made during the year, 800

As will be seen by the financial statement \$143.90 were collected by the visitors during the year. It is earnestly hoped that those contributing in this way will not decrease the amount of their contributions under the proposed change of visiting only once in three months. This change is necessitated by the small number taking part in the work, making it fall very heavily on the few.
