ho reason why this deficiency may not be supplied, it is hereby respectfully overtured that this Synod take this important subject into consideration and as it is believed that a Book Depot, under proper regulations, would best meet the case; and in order to prepare for a judicious adoption of some course of this kind, it is further overtured that a Committee of Syned be appointed, to make all needful enquiries into the subject, and to correspond with the Board of M.ssions in Scotland regarding it. And further, that in the meantime this Synod do hereby express their entire confidence in the integrity of the Rev. Charles Fletcher, one of the minsters, disabled from preaching, and now engaged as a Bookseller in the City of Toronto, and most cordially recommend him to the Board of Missions, and through them to their Booksellers and Publishers in Scotland, as a trustworthy and deserving person; and that from his knowelse of the country, and central position, he would be a very proper medium through whom the wants of the Congregations might meanwhile ne supplied, so far as arrangements can be made. All which is respectfully submitted.
