It has a concurrent jurisdiction, which is however seldom invoked, there being a salutary provision in the law that if any action is brought in the Supreme Court which could have been brought in an inferior tribuna', the plaintiff shall not be entitled to costs.

Even in this case, though, the Judge before whom the case is tried can remove the disadvantage, having the power to certify for costs, if he thinks there was reasonable grounds for bringing the action in the Supreme Court.

This Court may therefore well be named "Supreme," and this brief summary of its powers will show how deeply interested the people are in having its bench composed of persons, at once able and broadminded lawyers, and pure and unsullied men.
