



## 42 VICTORIA.

### CHAP. 15.

An Act to alter the Duties of Customs and Excise.

[Assented to 15th May, 1879.]

Amended by 48 Vic., cap. 18, 44 Vic., cap. 10, 45 Vic., cap. 6,  
46 Vic., cap. 13, and 47 Vic., cap. 30.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble.  
Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as  
follows:—

1. So much of all Acts and parts or schedules of Acts and <sup>Repeal of</sup> of all Orders in Council, as imposes any duty of Customs <sup>enactments</sup> upon goods (which word shall, for all the purposes of this <sup>imposing</sup> Act, have the meaning assigned to it in the Act passed in <sup>duties of</sup> the fortieth year of Her Majesty's reign and entitled; "*An* <sup>customs.</sup> *Act to amend and consolidate the Acts respecting the Customs,*")\* or exempts goods from Customs duty when imported into Canada, or is in anywise inconsistent with this Act, is hereby repealed; but any power conferred upon the Governor in Council by the Act last cited (40 Victoria, cap. 10\*) <sup>Saving cer-</sup> to transfer dutiable goods to the list of goods free of duty, <sup>tain power</sup> is not hereby abrogated or impaired:—and in lieu and <sup>under 40 V.,</sup> instead of all other duties of Customs upon goods imported <sup>c. 19.</sup> into Canada, there shall be raised, levied, collected and paid upon the goods enumerated in Schedule A to this Act, or referred to as not enumerated therein but charged with duty, <sup>Duties in</sup> imported into Canada or taken out of warehouse for con- <sup>Schedule A</sup> sumption therein, the several duties of Customs set forth and <sup>imposed.</sup> described in the said Schedule A and set opposite to each respectively, or charged on them as not enumerated, subject to the provisions hereinafter made.

2. The goods enumerated in Schedules B and C may, <sup>Goods free of</sup> subject to the provisions and conditions therein mentioned, <sup>duty.</sup> be imported into Canada or taken out of warehouse for consumption therein, without payment of any duty of Customs thereon.
