taining the objects for which the said Association was founded, it is desirable, that it should be incorporated: And whereas it is expedient that the prayer of the Petitioners should be granted, subject nevertheless to 5 the provisions hereinafter made: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

The Officers and Members of the Association incorporated.

Corporate name and powers.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the said officers and all such other persons as are now or shall hereafter be- 10. come members of the said Association, and their successors for ever, shall be and are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the Institut Canadien, and by that name shall have perpetual succession, 15 and may have a common seal, if they deem it expedient to have one one, which seal they may at their pleasure change, alter or break, and by the said name they may from time to time and at all times, acquire and pos- 20 sess in any manner whatsoever, for them and their successors and for the purposes of the said Corporation, any goods or property real or personal, provided the annual rerevenue of such real property shall not ex- 25 ceed the sum of pounds currency of this Province, and shall enjoy all such civil rights as are granted by the laws of this Province to other bodies politic or 30 corporate.

Proviso.

How service of process may be made on the Corporation.

II. And be it enacted, That in all suits and legal proceedings to be brought against the said Corporation, service of process at the domicile of the Recording Secretary of the Corporation, shall be sufficient service 35 thereof for all purposes of law.

Officers of the Corporation.

III. And be it enacted, That the Officers of the said Corporation shall be, a President, a first and second Vice-President, a Corresponding Secretary, a Recording Secretary, 40 an Assistant Recording Secretary, a Treasurer, a Librarian, and Assistant Librarian, and a Managing Committee, consisting of all
