### Drop/Add Dates

Sept. 25, 1987 Friday	Last day on which course additions can be made in first term courses or full-year courses.
Oct. 9, 1987 Friday	Last day to withdraw from first term courses without academic penalty.
Jan. 15, 1988 Friday	Last day for adding second term courses and last day to withdraw from full-year courses without academic penalty.
Jan 29, 1988	Last day to withdraw from second term courses without academic penalty.

The student is responsible for knowing the regulations pertaining to his/her program.

### Faculty Advisors

1. Faculty advisors are available to all students in the University.
2. Each faculty has its own procedures for assigning new students to their respective advisors prior to registration.
3. These advisors are available for consultation during the student's full stay on the campus.
4. In the faculties of Arts and Science, academic advising is provided by the Dean or Associate Deans for the student's first two years, with individual advisors appointed when the student selects his major program of study.
