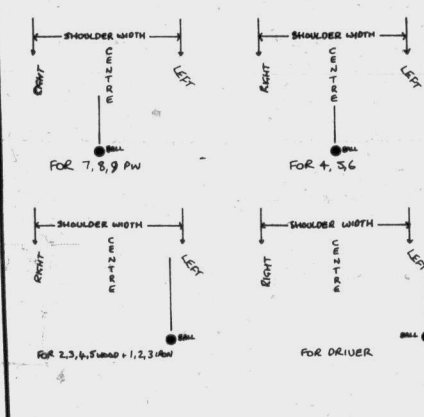


GOLF TIPS

 If you have been following this series of golf instruction then you require only the finishing touches to your new golf swing. First, you need to learn to aim. This is accomplished by standing behind the ball and looking over it toward the target. On the imaginary line drawn from the ball to the target, you select some small object (i.e. a broken tee, a blade of grass) that is about four feet in front of the ball. Stand beside the ball in the hitting position (no. 11) and project a line from the ball to your selected object. The lines across your feet, knees, hips and shoulders will be parallel to this line that joins the ball to your selected object. The club face will also be pointing over your selected spot. By studying the diagrams below you can see where to place your feet and the golf ball for each club in the bag.
