

to complete it, and before going elsewhere for subscriptions, he desires, and thinks it but right, the Six Nations should head the list, which would induce other contributions.

Several Chiefs having spoken, the Supt. thought it well to say a few words in support of the application.

They should remember, that all the Church buildings on their Reserve (Six Nations), were built for them, with such their being - I believe - asked to subscribe, beyond perhaps some individual labour. St. John's Church was erected by the Am. Reformed Company, and St. Paul's (Kamjogok) fine brick building, and its Parsonage, also by the same Companies. Such Churches, are to the advantage and improvement of their people, while they are an ornament to, and increase the value of their Reserve.

They have already, from time to
