I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter. of the 9th inst., reporting the murder committed at Hat Creek by an Indian who shot and killed a young woman while asleep in her tent and note what you say as to the arrangement made by the Provincial Authorities with the Chief whereby the capture of the Indian was to be left to the Chief for thirty days.
