

At the commencement of the year the Club numbered 432 members; but during the year it has lost 3 members by death and 12 in consequence of removal from Leeds or inability to attend meetings. The number of members at the present time is, therefore, 417. There is, however, an especially large number of candidates seeking election—evidence of the Club's value and virility.

The Honorary Treasurer's report still shows a credit balance, and this in spite of the exceptional year of expenditure and the subscription of 100 guineas to the University Fund.
