is anxious to contest the seat sgain or not. He says that Dr. Gauthier probably thinks of running but would have no shance of success. The constituency it appears is mostly English speaking, although many speaking English have French names. It is, of course, to some extent French speaking as well. Grattan is a man who would be very popular as a candidate. He is, as you know, Irish Catholic and has a great many admirers throughout the Dominion. Of course you know also he was brought up in Gaspé county.

Think the matter over. I only wish to add that I am personally anxious to have Mr. O'Leary in Parliament if a way can be found.
