The report goes on to say that the convention should be annulled and, if not, it would be the cause of misunderstandings and difficulties. No conservative in the County of Richelieu can accept Boulais who is a stranger in Richelieu and who is supported by Napoléon Latraverse and Aimé Chassé.

The only way to remedy to the whole situation will be for Mr. Boulais to declare that he does not accept the nomination.

A convention could then be called with the approval of the Chief Organizer in the proper way after notices published in every parishes, and the candidate then selected will meet with the approval of the whole Conservative Party of Richelieu.
