



Sir,-

With reference to the second paragraph of your letter of the 15th instant No. 116 I have to say that the question of the claim of Powawassan and his band to lands in the Wild Lands reserve at Hungry Hall was fully enquired into a number of years ago. It appears that Powawassan has no claim to the Reserve No. 37 at Hungry Hall, which was surveyed in error by Mr. Vaughan, D.L.S. Powawassan's followers residing there received their land with "The Bishop" Reserve No. 14. The whole of the said Reserve No. 37 forms a part of the Wild Lands reserve.
