I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th ultimo, enclosing applications for the admission of six orphan children from Clearwater Lake to the Norway House Boarding School and enclosing several communications with reference thereto.


In reply I beg to say it is considered that these children are protestants and are eligible for admission to the Norway House Boarding School.

The admission of Willie, Louisa and Lucy Etwacopow, Betay Moneas and Anna Miller is approved as is also the re-admission of Joel Moneas. With reference to the last named the principal should see that this boy receives every care and attention.

It is presumed that a number of pupils will be receiving their discharge at the end of the present quarter and the above children can replace them as regular grant earning pupils.

You will be good enough to inform the principal of the approval of the admission of the above named children.
