Lease 120 - Dwight C. Rounds,
Land on Semiahmoo Indian Reserve.

Referring to your letter of the 4th instant and prior correspondence, in connection with transfer by Mr. Dwight C. Rounds of a portion of the land held by him under this lease to the District of Surrey, I beg to say that, according to the last item in July Rent Return--15th to 31st--there was paid by the Corporation of the District of Surrey the sum of \$50.00--rental from 9th September, 1929 to 9th September, 1931--for one-half acre of land on the Semiahmoo Indian Reserve, under "Permit of 9th Sept., 1929, during pleasure."

For your information and guidance a synopsis of Permit and lease is given, showing that in both instances rental is payable on 1st March in each year being the date from which occupation was granted:-

Permit: (F. 13,153/2) Letter dated 26th February, 1925, granting Campbell River Mills permission to use small parcel of land on Semiahmoo Indian Reserve, "during pleasure," from 1st March 1925,--\$15.00 per annum, yearly in advance.

Lease 120, dated 20th August, 1925, Campbell River Mills, Limited, transferred to C. Rounds, 1st March, 1928; area 36.57 acres; 24 years from 1st March, 1926; rental, \$15.00 per annum, payable yearly in advance.

In the proposed sub-lease sub-lease consideration reference is made to the land held by Mr. Dwight C. Rounds, stated as
