

- Q.131 Col. Turcot told you there was a vacancy for a CQMS in the Royal 22e Regt?
- A.131 Yes, Sir.
- Q.132 What steps were taken by HQ Quebec Command to move you?
- A.132 No steps at all. They always kept saying we will see you in a couple of weeks.
- Q.133 What steps did you take to bring this to the attention of HQ?
- A.133 I wrote a letter to Major F de S Robert and at a visit in Sherbrooke I asked him what was the situation. I told him about my interview with Col. Turcot and he said I had to put a letter through HQ Quebec Command stating my interview with Col. Turcot, so I did.
- Q.134 Do you recognize this letter as a facsimile, a true certified copy of that letter?
- A.134 That is right, Sir.
- Q.135 Will you present it to the Court, please?
- A.135 Yes, Sir.
- Certified true copy of said letter is signed by the President and attached to the proceedings. See document marked "K"
- Q.136 Did the OC of the Reserve Force Unit to which you were attached agree with your transfer?
- A.136 The O.C.? Yes Sir, correspondence went through on that matter that Col. Roy will let me go without replacement in order to straighten out my personal affairs. It costs too much to keep a house in Sherbrooke and one in Montreal.
- Q.137 Do you recognize this letter as a facsimile, a certified true copy of letter signed by Col. Roy, and will you produce it?
- A.137 Right, Sir.
- Certified true copy of letter dated 1 Dec 48, signed by Lt-Col Roy, is signed by the President and attached to the proceedings. See document marked "L"
- Q.138 When did you cease attempting to get a transfer?
- A.138 I ceased, well I came back to see Major Robert at the beginning of Feb, before I was going to my Winter Course. I asked him for my transfer or a discharge. Before I went to my Winter Training Course in Valcartier and then I asked for my discharge also to Capt Lafleur and he called Maj Robert down to his office and then Major Robert came to his office and tried to talk me off taking my discharge by stating what money he earned himself and I earned myself and Capt Lafleur said after that, "If you want your discharge, there is no use for you to go on the Winter Training Course". My reply was if
