Dear Sir:

I beg to transmit herewith voucher No.3082 dated December 8th 1937 amounting to \$94.50 in favor of Dr. P.C. Bruner, together with a copy of a covering letter from Mr. Indian Agent Irwin.

If the Department made the arrangement with Dr. Bruner to supply the seed, as indicated, the amount could be met out of the \$712.36 received from the sale of wheat from the 45 acres of the reclaimed area sown by Dr. Bruner for the Indians, and which sum was forwarded to the Department by Mr. Irwin in the latter part of January for deposit to the funds of the band, account No.111, if the Department considers this should be done before final adjustment is made with Dr. Bruner.
