UNRIVALLED LOCATION.

Due to its unrivalled location at the confluence of two great rivers, and as the divisional point of two railway systems, Prince George must become the distributing centre for the whole of Central British Columbia, including the vast undeveloped Peace River section of the province.

The Pacific Great Eastern Railway which will connect the North country with the cities of the Pacific coast is now being rapidly built towards Prince George from the south by the British Columbia Government. Premier Oliver has stated that the road will be completed to Prince George in 1920, and this is a reasonable prediction from the fact that 80 per cent of the grade is already completed.
