TO TRAVELLERS.

For the information of Travellers between Windsor and Parrsborough, &c.
THE Parrsborough packet sails regularly between Windsor and Parrsborough every week, from the first of April to Christmas, viz: leaves Parrsborough on Monday, wind and weather permitting so as to be at Windsor on Tuesday; and will sail from thence the first high water that happens at or after eight o'clock in the afternoon of that Day: the packet frequently goes twice or three times a week, when business requires it.
The vessel is upwards of 50 tons burthen, and has very good accommodations for passengers, and likewise for carrying horses, neat cattle and sheep.
