All goods manufactured in Bond shall, if taken out of Bond for consumption in Canada, be subject to duties of Excise equal to the duties of Customs to which they would be subject if imported from Great Britain and entered for consumption in Ganada; and whenever any article not the produce of Canada, upon which a duty of Excise would be levied if produced in Canada, is taken into a bonded Manufactory, the difference between the duty of Excise to which it would be so liable and the Customs duty which would be levied on such article, if imported and entered for consumption, shall be paid as duty of Excise when it is taken into the Bonded
