CATHOLIC.

THE CHURCH OF OUR LADY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, is a magnificent structure built of Guelph limestone, in rock-faced ashlar, with cut stone mouldings, niches, canopies, &c &c. It stands isolated on the most elevated site in the city, at the west end of Macdonnell Street. Begun in 1876 was completed in 1888 with the the exception of the upper part of the towers and spires. The church has a seating capacity of 1800. Holy Mass is celebrated on Sundays at 7:30 and 10:30 a. m., and also at 5.30 a. m. on Holy days of Obligation falling on week - days, and on every morning during the year at 6:30 and 8.00 on Sundays. Festivals first Friday of the month, and during the Lenton season, Rosary, Sermon, and Bendiction at 7:30 p. m.; Sunday School at 3:30 p. m. In connection with the Church and under the direction of the Fathers are the Societies of St Vincent de Paul, the League of the Cross, the Catholic Mutual Benevolent Society, Sodalities of men, of the married ladies, of the young ladies, of the children, boys & girls.
