- VI. GESTURE HYMN.
- VII. SUPPLEMENTAL LESSON. Recite Golden Texts for the Quarter, as far as learned.
- TEACHER—What did Jesus say about little children?
CLASS—Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not; for of such is the kingdom of heaven.
TEACHER—Let us hear what message Jesus has for us to-day.
- VIII. THE LESSON for the day, with Golden Text, Lesson Hymn and Catechism.
- IX. PRAYER. In simple words and short clauses by the teacher, the children repeating.
- X. SING LESSON HYMN for the Quarter, 525, Book of Praise—
- I want to be like Jesus,
Engaged in doing good,
So that of me it may be said:
“She hath done what she could.”
- XI. IN CONCERT. The Lord shall preserve thy going out and coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.
