Moore Co., to cost about \$9,000.—The International Harvester Co. will build a large wharf.—The Westinghouse Co. have come to an agreement with the city. Work will soon be commenced on the new building.—The Bank of Hamilton will build a branch bank on Barton street.

**VICTORIA, B. C.**—The Provincial Government proposes to build a bridge across the Fraser river at Savonas.—Tenders are wanted by the Government by 24th inst. for erection of school house at Chilliwack.—The bridge across the Chemainus river near Captain Barklay's will be rebuilt.—J. C. M. Keith has completed plans for an extensive block to be built by an English syndicate on Tronche Avenue, between Government and Broad streets; pressed brick and stone, ornamented iron columns, iron and glass roof, plate glass windows, elevators, etc.—Tenders are about to be invited for Carnegie library building; Hooper & Watkins, architects.
