The Kane Expedition.

We left New York 31st May, 1853. The passage to Baffin's Bay was without incident. We stopped at various Danish colonies in Greenland to provide ourselves with furs and Esquimaux dogs. Reached the first ice in Melville Bay later part of July.

On the 21st of June we were afloat, and giving chase to the horizon. Our duty for the northward for the purpose of making deposits for navigators and for our party, which we intended sending out in the spring to prosecute the search for Franklin; in this respect we travelled about 400 miles in a north-easterly direction.
