

Yeas,

Messieurs Huot, Papineau, Black, Tet , Perinault, De Bonne, Dumas, Fisser, Plant , Bidard, Lees, Bernier, Martineau and Mr. Attorney General.

Nays,

Messieurs Cuthbert, N. Coffin, Craigie, Young and Grant.

And the same being carried by a majority of nine votes.

ORDERED, that the said clause be added to the Bill.

Mr. Papineau moved, seconded by Mr. Dumas, that the amendments voted by this House to the engrossed Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled, " Act to repeal and amend certain parts of an Act passed in " the thirty-fourth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled " An Act for " the division of the Province of *Lower Canada*, for amending the Jurisdiction thereof and for repealing certain Laws therein mentioned," be engrossed.

The House divided upon the question,

Yeas 11

Nays 6

And the same being carried by a majority of five—

ORDERED, that the said amendments be engrossed.

And then on motion of Mr. Dumas, seconded by Mr. Papineau,

The House adjourned till Friday next.
