that an Act may pass, securing to Petitioner the exclusive right to his discovery and improvement in the manufacture of malleable or bar Iron and Steel.

Ordered, That the said Petition be referred to a Special Committee, to report thereon by Bill, or otherwise, with power to send for persons, papers, and records.

Ordered, That Mr. Attorney General, Mr. Forgan and Mr. Aldous, be a Committee for that purpose.

On motion, the House was adjourned during pleasure, and put into a Committee on the Bill intituled "An Act to continue and amend the Act to prevent Horses, Swine and Geese going at large in Georgetown."—After some time, the House was resumed, and Mr. Aldous reported, that the Committee had gone through the Bill, and had agreed to the same, without any amendment.

Ordered, That the Report of the Committee be received.

Ordered, That the said Bill be read the third time on Monday next.

Mr. Attorney General presented to the House the Impost Accounts for Charlottetown, for the year ending 31st December, 1856;

Also,

The Impost Accounts for the several Out Ports in this Island, for the same period.

Ordered, That the said Accounts do lie on the Table.

Mr. Attorney General also presented to the House, the Public Accounts for the past year, as arranged and classified by the Auditors;

Also,

The Returns of the State of the Bank of Prince Edward Island, to the 4th March, 1857.

Ordered, That the said Accounts and Returns do lie on the Table.

Adjourned until Monday next, at One o'clock.
