

SENATORSHIP IN A DEAL

Senator Ratz Was Anxious to Secure Job—He Denies That Any Deal Was Made.

Barrie, Ont., Oct. 21.—A statement of claim, and a statement of defence in the action brought by Absalom Mercer, son of the late Senator Samuel Mercer, against Senator Valentine Ratz, have been filed here, and the case will probably go to trial in December at the Barrie assizes. Mercer sues to recover \$1,400, which he alleges is due under an agreement, which he says was made between his father and defendant in July 1906. By this alleged agreement Senator Mercer was to resign and create a vacancy in the senate, into which Mr. Ratz could step. In consideration of his resignation it was agreed that Mr. Ratz was to pay the plaintiff's father \$1,400 on the first of May, 1909, and \$1,000 a year thereafter, as long as he or his wife, Mrs. Ellen Mercer lived. Hon. Samuel Mercer died on Aug. 11th, 1908. In his defence Senator Ratz denies that he is a party to any such agreement, and states that Senator Mercer's resignation is due to his insolvency. If there was any such agreement it would be in the gift of the sale of an office in the gift of the crown, and void as against public policy. It would also be void under the Ontario statutes as being the sale of an office concerning the administration of justice.

NEWS OF THE PROVINCE.

Carlyle will instal a waterworks system.

R. H. Scott has been elected mayor of Alameda.

The Canadian Bank of Commerce has opened a branch at Yorkton.

The settlers of Cut Knife will send a delegation to Premier Scott to demand a branch of the C.N.R.

Canora school board contemplate building a two-room addition to present school and raising up high school work.

A new mail service has been inaugurated on the C.N.R. line south of Wolsley, as a consequence of the new fast service between Winnipeg and Prince Albert. Just how the service is arranged we have not learned, but evidently there is no exchange at Kaiser, for letters mailed at Genavo on Saturday for Wolsley went around by Winnipeg and did not get there until Wednesday.

W. Hedge, a Carlyle boy, was on Saturday brought before Magistrate Stent on the charge of giving liquor to R. Oliver, an intoxicated person. The evidence went to show that the lad had not a full comprehension of the meaning of the word intoxicated, though he knew that an intoxicated person could not himself obtain liquor. While the minimum penalty for the above offence is \$50, or two months, in consideration of the youth of the lad the magistrate reserved his decision until Saturday next in order to place the matter before the Attorney-General's department. R. Oliver, the intoxicated person was fined \$5 and costs for obtaining liquor. H. H. Higgins, \$5 and costs on a similar charge.

NEW HOTEL. Duncan, Kennedy, of Saskatoon, will erect a \$75,000 hotel in Saskatoon.

DROPPED DEAD. While plowing on Tuesday, Jacob Hald, a Rosthern farmer, dropped dead.

INCREASE CAPACITY. The Robin Hood Flour Mill is increasing their plant to 1,500 barrels per day.

NEW JAIL. Governor McMullen has assumed his duties as governor of the new jail at Mooseomin which is now ready for occupation.

FOR MAYOR. A widely signed petition has been presented to A. J. Bell, asking him to be a candidate for mayor of Prince Albert. If Mr. Bell accepts the present mayor will not be a candidate.

FOREST FIRES. Prospectors report fierce forest fires are raging in the timber limits to the north of Pasquia Mission. The burnt area covers a distance of nearly 20 miles.

CARNDUFF GROWING. Many handsome residences, an up-to-date hotel, a splendid bank building and a brick building block are the results of a building boom in Carnduff. The town is also considering the taking over of the telephone system and the lighting plant.

CHARGED WITH PERJURY. Mayor Macdonald, and City Clerk Davidson, Prince Albert, appeared in

court on Thursday charged with perjury by H. C. Beatty, late secretary of the board of trade. Beatty has no counsel and the case was adjourned until Tuesday.

ELECTION TODAY. An election will be held in Grenfell today when the question of the incorporation as a town will be decided. The population has been sufficient for some years, but the people have preferred the status of a village to the expenses of a town.

SANITARIUM. A company which consists of prominent Winnipeg and Saskatchewan men, have formed a company with \$235,000 capital to build a sanitarium at Little Manitou Lake near Watrous. The directors have decided to go ahead with the building at once.

PRINCIPAL O. K. A meeting of the trustees of New Hope S. D. No. 91, was called for Saturday to consult some petitions that had been handed in respecting the principal. After going thoroughly into the matter it was found that no ground for complaint existed and the school was being conducted as it should.

EVANGELISTIC SERVICES. Commencing at Fleming Nov. 14th, and including Mooseomin, Whitewood, Wapella and Broadview, a two week's evangelistic campaign will be conducted. Revs. Russell, of Wolsley, and Davis of Indian Head, are expected to assist the local pastors in the good work.

AT THE TOP. The hamlet of Shell Brook, Sask., is applying for permission to be organized as a village. If the community can comply with the requirements and succeed in their desires, Shell Brook will be the most northerly village in the province of Saskatchewan, as it is located in township 49, range 3, west of the third meridian.

SAD AND SORRY. Lee Took, who is doing a term of nine months at the Regina jail, feels his position very keenly, judging by a letter he wrote to a Weyburn clergyman some days ago. The request in the letter to the clergyman was to the effect that a petition be made to the authorities granting Lee Took a pardon, or lessened term of imprisonment.

CAPTURED. Dr. Bob Zimmerman was in Craik on the charge of stealing from Dr. Truman was captured at Lumsden. The stolen articles were found in his room. At his trial at Craik he was sentenced to six months in Regina jail. Zimmerman has had an eventful career. He was once a practicing dentist in Hamilton, but drank was his downfall and for years has lived a life of crime.

WOLF! WOLF! While driving into town one day last week, Mr. C. Gray was attacked by a pack of vicious wolf hounds, owned by a farmer north of town, and claims that if he had not got on his wagon there is little doubt but that they would have inflicted serious injury. We have heard several farmers and some of the townspeople complain of this same pack and would advise the owner to either destroy or keep the pack chained if he would avoid trouble.—Wapella Post.

FLAX STOLEN. When Jacob Jeyskinsky, of the New Warren district, went to his granary on Monday morning, he found that three hundred bushels of flax had been stolen. A week ago, Monday, he had been to see it, and it was all right, so it was in the intervening time that the theft was made. Two wagons on tracks led from the building, but it was impossible to trace them for any great distance. Jeyskinsky came into town in the afternoon and wired for the R.N.W.M.P. officer at Milestone, and while he is suspicious of who committed the theft and claims he can identify his flax, yet it is doubtful if a conviction can be made.—Rouleau Enterprise.

A HISTORIC CANE. Mr. R. Claude Kisbey returned on Friday morning from an extended visit with friends in Ireland and England. Mr. Kisbey finds that there is considerable interest manifested among the better class in Ireland in the prospects offered by Canada to homeseekers. An interesting memento of his visit was secured by Mr. Kisbey in the shape of a blackthorn cane which his father, Judge Kisbey gave him. The stick was cut by Buyers, a victim of an agrarian outrage in 1867, and was presented to Judge Kisbey in recognition of his activity in promoting a fund for the relief of the family of the murdered family.—Estevan Mercury.

WILL EXHIBIT. Hugh Sutherland, chairman of the executive committee of the International Exhibition and Sellsirk Centennial, referring to the reply of the Saskatchewan government, said: "We have had the reply of the Saskatchewan government for the past couple of weeks and we consider it quite satisfactory. The reply states that the province will make satisfactory exhibits, and that is all we expect any government to do. Of course they do not state that they will expend \$250,000 or any other sum, but it was hardly expected they would, as the needs of making a satisfactory

exhibit may require perhaps more, perhaps less, than that amount.

WILL CONTINUE. The Tisdale Monitor referring to the illness of Mr. Hines cannot refrain from including a sneer at the Farmers' Railway Co. pretending to wonder if it is possible to get a saner man than Mr. Hines to be president of the company. For the information of our contemporary we must state that 800 farmers and others have signed for shares in this company and the directors intend going right ahead with the business. If they do not, then the shareholders will probably will be the same thing. The farmers railway will be built, Mr. Monitor, and will soon play a big part in the development of the whole province of Saskatchewan. You must not forget that the head of the great British Empire went crazy once upon a time.—Melfort Journal.

NABBED. A few weeks ago the local loan agents received confidential letters from Winnipeg, advising them that the writer had unlimited funds to loan on almost any kind of security, at seven per cent interest. Much elevated the agents went their way to canvas for business, and many "prospects" were secured. It now appears that similar letters were sent all over the country, and were the introductory play to a well laid swindle. The sender of the letters, M. A. Moore, is now in the cells at Winnipeg, on a charge of using the mails for fraudulent purposes. He was nabbed by the police before his scheme began to bring returns. The ruse-off is now arriving and is being gathered in by the prosecuting attorney. Notes drafts and hard cash in various amounts are coming in from various victims of the scheme.—Estevan Mercury.

A RICH LAND. News was received in the city today that twenty thousand bushels of wheat were received at Swift Current's four elevators yesterday. Yet the first elevator at Swift Current was built last year! The country adjacent to Swift Current has been openly declared to be unfit for grain growing, and ten years ago it is said there was not a bushel of wheat grown within a wide radius of that point. Many unfamiliar with the recent swift development there still labor under the impression that the country is "little good" for the raising of grain, yet official figures show that 20,000 bushels of wheat were received at the elevators at Swift Current in one day. And the "goodness" of the country, that built the first elevator at Swift Current last year was a current topic among those who only knew that country as it appeared a few years ago. This is but another illustration of the growth and resources of the Canadian west.—Winnipeg Tribune.

TYPHOID EPIDEMIC. The hospital can scarcely accommodate the number of applicants for admission during the last few weeks. Last week there were seven fever patients. Fever seems to have taken a hold of Mooseomin and district this fall, and the cause is unknown. And sickness from general causes is prevalent keeping the doctors busy day and night. When typhoid cases become numerous, and no direct cause is known, people find causes, and the blame is often fixed on an innocent cause. Just now the water in the town tank is blamed, and yet that water cannot well be guilty. It comes from a depth of 150 feet in a well built of cement, which cannot permit of any surface water entering. However, to make no mistake about it, ten samples of this water, taken from ten different parts of the water works system, have been sent to be analysed. If typhoid is germs exist they will be discovered and the report will be here in a few days. A sample of water from suspected wells have also been sent.—Spectator.

A BAD ACTOR. Accused of cruelty and adultery, Adam Diebert, residing in the German colony at Springdale, did not appear in Regina on Tuesday to contest the suit for alimony entered by his wife Katie. W. M. Martin, M.P., appeared for the wife, and J. C. Seccord cross-examined her witnesses in the interests of the husband. It appears from Mrs. Diebert's evidence that she was married by Father Von Hirtren in the fall of 1893, and ceased to live with her husband in December of the year following. There was one child of the marriage. Contrary to her wishes her husband took her to live with his father and mother, and disputes between her mother-in-law and herself soon arose. Three days after her child was born the defendant ordered her out of bed to do household work, at the instigation of his mother, and on another occasion he beat her because she did some stacking the wrong way. He refused to provide her with a house apart from his parents, and with his parents accused her of immorality, and he setting that the child was not his. Afterwards he went to the States. Mrs. Diebert said she was prepared to return to her husband if he would provide a home of his own. And she could prove that he had no improper relations with other women, but one of her witnesses declared that Adam Diebert has been living for some time with a German girl at his parents' home. A decree as to alimony was reserved.

TRAGIC EVENT AT MOOSE JAW

Two Young Men Killed by Driving Over Bank—Lived in Moose Jaw District.

Moose Jaw, Oct. 21.—A tragic occurrence resulting in the death of one young man, and serious injuries to another, took place one mile and a half from the city this morning. The dead man's name was Jonathan Green, and that of his companion Jacob Carlson. The young fellows both of whom are farmers living in the district, visited town yesterday to attend a party given by some friends, and started for home at an early hour this morning. With the evident intention of taking a short cut from the city, the young men made an attempt to get over the railway crossing situated a mile and a half west of the city. Owing to the extreme darkness they apparently missed their trail and drove their horse over a fifteen foot embankment, running alongside the track. The accident was discovered at daybreak by a workman who found the body of Green lying by the side of the horse. Both were dead. His companion was found nearby lying in an unconscious state. Carlson now lies in the local hospital in a serious condition, with several fractures on his right leg, in addition to many body bruises.

BILL ROBINSON WAS A BIG MAN IN EGYPT.

It was within two months of 21 years ago, Capt. William Robinson, "Captain Bill," as we of the olden time in Winnipeg knew him, will forgive the yarn.

It is not a yarn, merely an incident of the Gordon Relief Expedition up the Nile in 1884-85, hardly worth recalling, if it were not to show how an unobtrusive Winnipegger became a man of note for a brief quarter of an hour along the historic banks of the river that from the days of Moses Anthony and Cleopatra, has provided more stories than any other watercourse in the world.

It was the latter end of October or the early part of November—it was a calendarless time for us voyagers of the Gordon Relief Expedition, and one cannot be sure within a week or two—and the advance boats of the expedition were fighting their way wearily through the worst rapids of the turbulent Nile above Wady Halfa, then the border city of Egypt on the river before entering the weary waste deserts of the Sudan.

It was trying, heart breaking work on the river from daylight until dark and the first symptoms of homesickness was taking possession of all those of us who had hitherto only known the exigencies of life in a shattered home in far off Canada.

The postal service of the expedition had not been regulated, and the vagrant Canadian voyagers, continually passing up and down the river, ordered at different cataraacts and stationed at rapids on account of the rapidly rising river arose in a night, were practically cut off from communication with their friends in Canada.

One evening just before the quick sundown of the Sudan—there is no gloaming or twilight in the mystical orient—the boats of the expedition were drawn up at intervals that the rapid stream river would permit.

There was the intense quiet of the coming Egyptian night undisturbed by the exhausted men of the expedition of toil and the only sound was that of the stord river, that a few days before had swept by the walls of Khartoum, where the great Christian Knight of the 19th century was battling a prisoner, against the myraid hordes of Arab Africa. The silence was suddenly broken by the sound of a steamboat whistle and soon we could hear above the subdued roar of the river the beating of the screw of a small steam launch.

A number of Canadians had collected from the various boats—of the clamminess of our kind—and we stood and watched with curious and professional interest the mastery manner in which the approaching boat took advantage of every eddy and backwater of the swiftly flowing river.

"The man that's at that wheel," said Jim McBurney, a veteran Minnesotan man, eyeing the workmanlike manner in which the launch was being handled, "knows his business."

He did. Years at the helm of many a steamboat on the Red river of the north had taught that steersman much.

"I wonder who it can be?" said Col. Kennedy, strolling up to the group of Manitoba voyagers, nearly all of them he had known in civil life on the border of the Red River.

"Some big gun, I would think sir," said Larry Clark, now the clerk of the High Court at Calgary.

"Big gun or not," said Jack Doyle the best steersman that ever put hand to tiller on the Nile. "The man that's pushing that wheel knows fast water when he sees it."

U.S. SENATOR PASSES AWAY. Senator Jonston of North Dakota, Dead—Known to Many Canadians. Fargo, N.D., Oct. 31.—United States Senator, M. N. Johnson, of North Dakota, died at a hotel in this city tonight of acute bright's disease. He had been for a short time under medical treatment, and the disease developed rapidly following a slight nasal operation. He was to have left here in a day or two to join the Taft party in the south, and to complete the balance of a trip around Washington from New Orleans, John-
